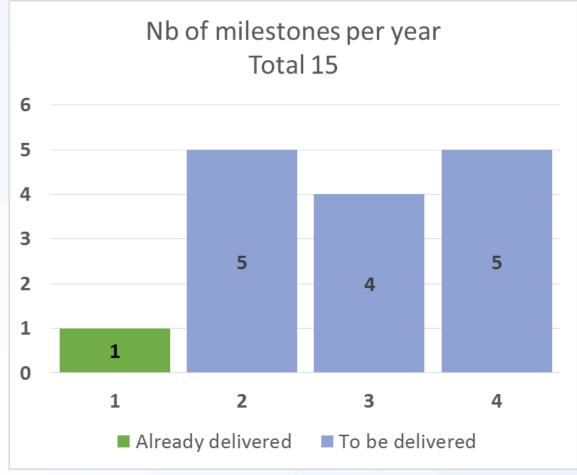
#### **Total of 27 deliveries**

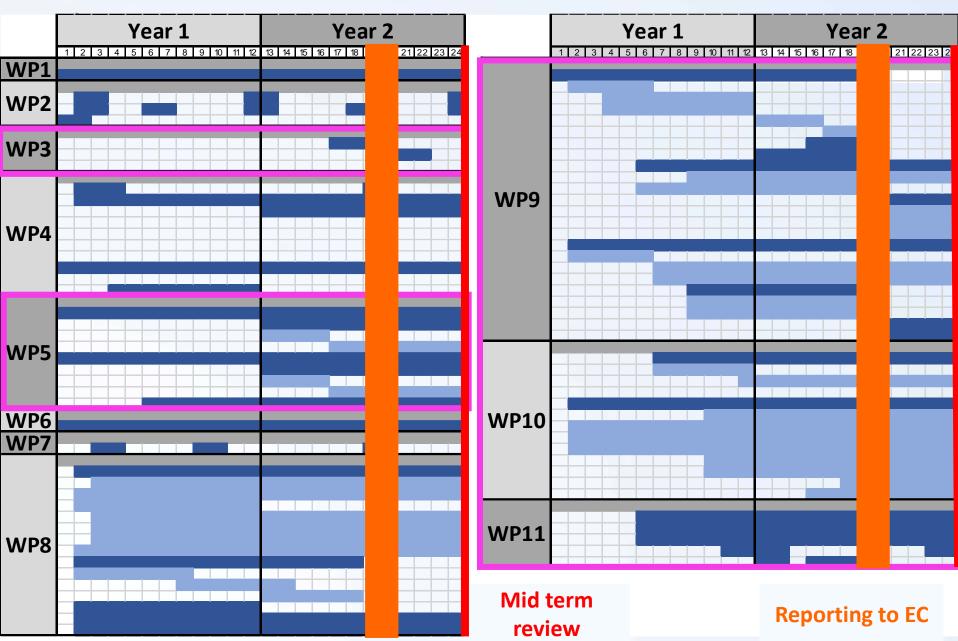

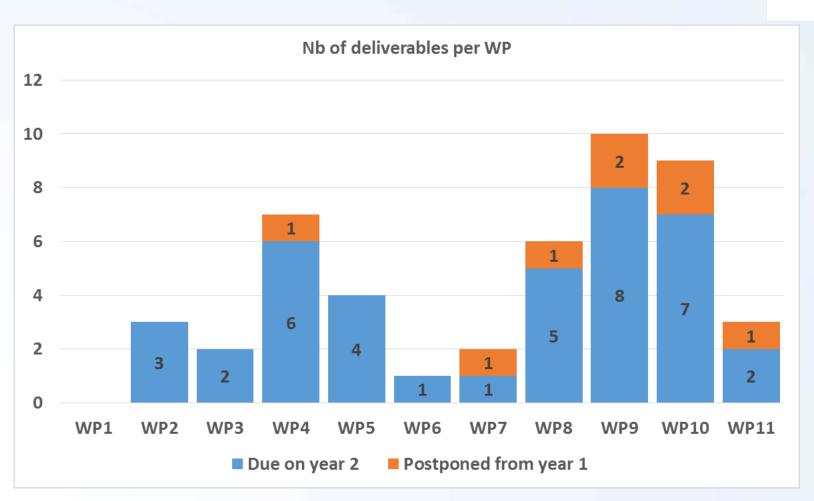

  - PO sends a Word template to all WP leaders
  - Each WP leader writes her/his WP report and send it back to the PO
