

Dear colleagues,

Here are the graphs for monitoring the SeaDataNet catalogues content (all documents are available on the extranet of the project under [SeaDataNet II > Follow up](#)).

You can see that there are **increases** on all catalogues **except EDIOS**: EDMO (+3), EDMED (+3), EDMERP (+1), CSR (+353) and CDI (+9 198) (see Figure 1).

For April 2013, the increase in the CDI catalogue is the following (see also Figure 2 and 3):

3273 new CDI records have also been input in the CDI catalogue by Geo-Seas partners (NGU, Norway + 2762 and BGS, UK, +511), which leads to a total increase of **9 198 records** in CDI.

**1 new data centre is connected: ICES** (Denmark).

4 data providers are still not connected but are working on the connection: **IGEWE** (Albania), **INRH** (Morocco), **TUBITAK-SHODB** (Turkey), **UniHb** (Germany).
