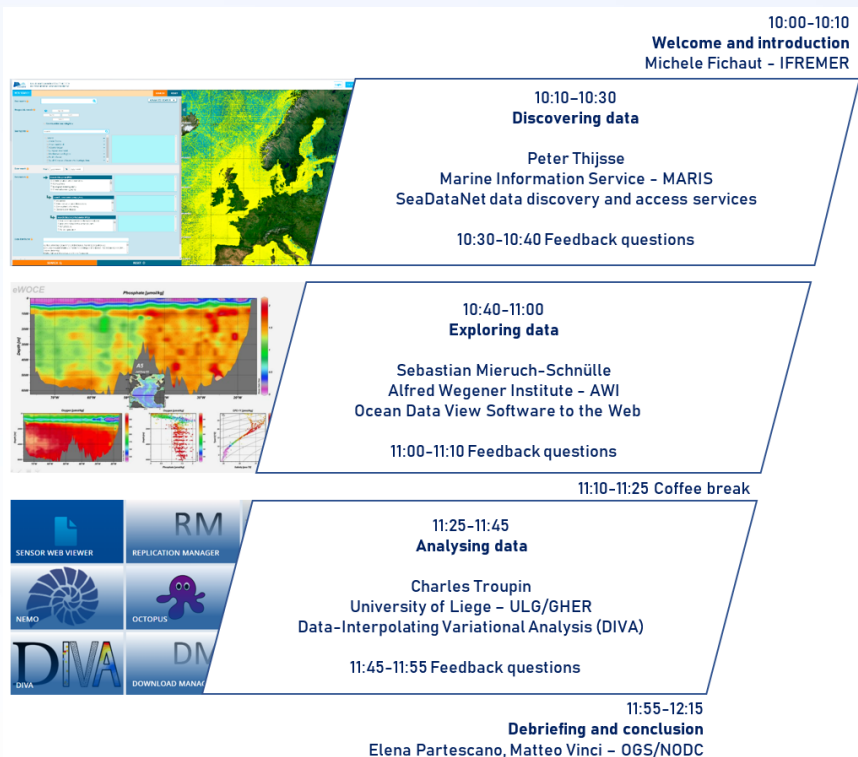
## Pre-registration and coordination

# Workshop Day



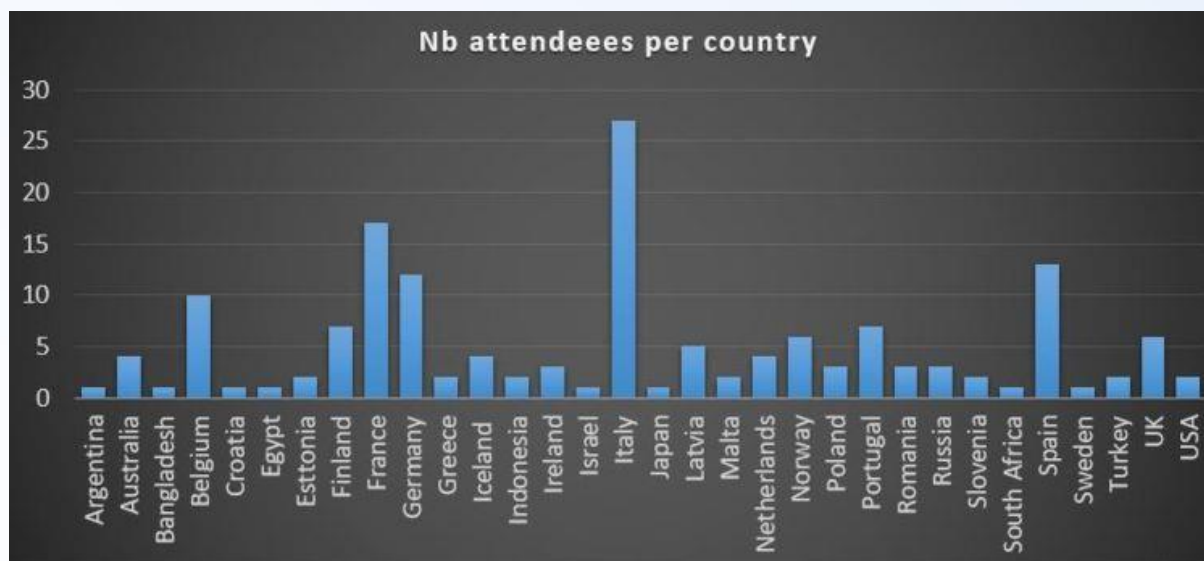
The workshop started on time at 10.00:

After each session, time for some questions was given using the Questions and Answers Cisco<sup>®</sup> tool


## Workshop Day

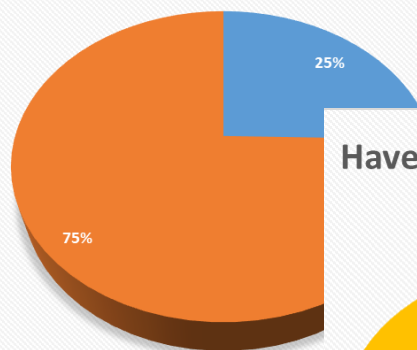

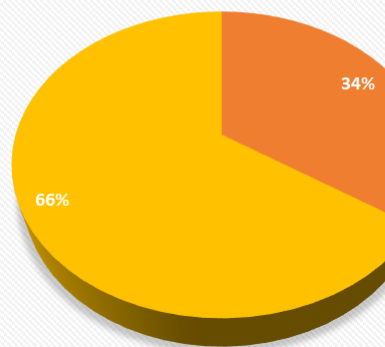

Have you ever used SDN services?

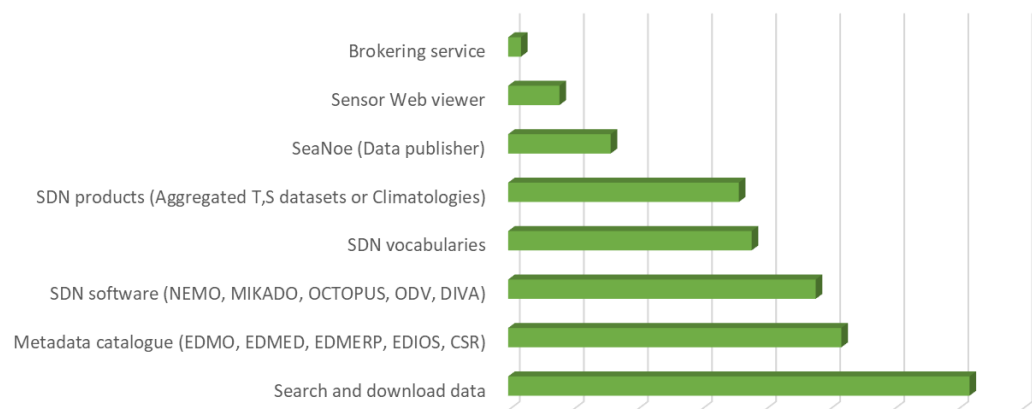


The results of the survey are positive:


the majority of participants already used SeaDataNet website and services in particular SeaDataNet vocabularies, metadata catalogs, software and discovery interface.
